- Continue your journey at the [Oxnard Historic Farm Park](#), where vintage farm equipment, original buildings and lush gardens showcase Oxnard's agricultural roots.

LUNCH

- Enjoy a relaxed lunch at [Café Amri](#), a local favorite with hearty Californian comfort dishes.

AFTERNOON

- History: Travel to [Camarillo Ranch House](#) for a guided tour of the beautifully preserved 1892 Queen Anne-style home. Afterwards, visit Ventura's [Olivas Adobe](#), a historic 1841 adobe estate that brings early California rancho life to life through exhibits and storytelling.
- Craft & Culinary: Conclude your experience at [Magnavino Cellars](#) for a flavorful tasting, followed by dinner at [Dominic's Italian Restaurant](#).

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Day 01 – OXNARD

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Day 02 – CAMARILLO & VENTURA

MORNING	History: Tour the Camarillo Ranch House , for a guided tour of the beautifully preserved 1892 Queen Anne–style home, then stroll Old Town Camarillo , a walkable district filled with local boutiques, cafés and eateries.
LUNCH	Adolfo Grill , American & California cuisine featuring locally sourced ingredients, handcrafted dishes and a well-curated bar with top-shelf spirits, all served in a welcoming, community-focused setting.
AFTERNOON	Explore Olivas Adobe , a historic 1841 adobe estate that brings early California rancho life to life through exhibits and storytelling.
DINNER	Cafe Zack , American cuisine known for expertly prepared steaks, including a signature Filet Mignon, served in an intimate, upscale dining setting.
